The YMCA daycares that are situated at the schools begin accepting applications on January 1, 2018 for the September 2018 school year. We recommend that interested parents apply via email by submitting an application form on January 1st to avoid disappointment. The YMCA daycares offer childcare for Kindergarten aged children up to age 12.

The Windermere Early Learning Center offers child care to infants up to and including Kindergarten aged children. The Windermere Day Care offers child care from 12 months up to 12 years of age. Both of these daycares have ongoing waitlist and parents are encouraged to apply early once they know their schooling plans.

The Sing, Sign, Laugh & Learn program is offered at 10:00am and 11:15am every Wednesday as well as a Pop Up Library.

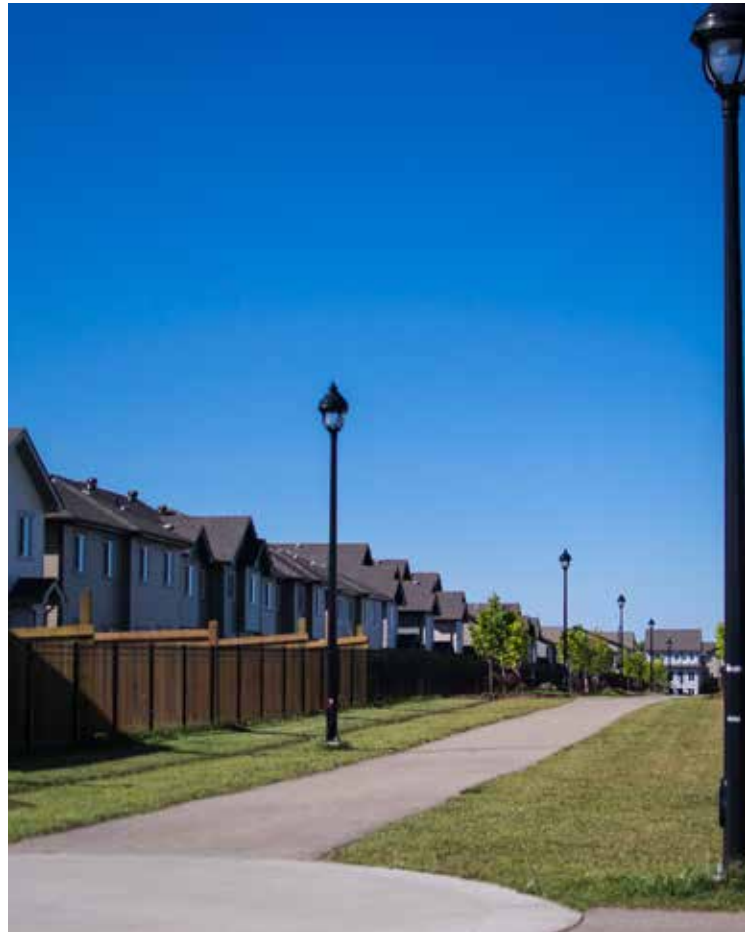

WHO ARE WE?

The Greater Windermere Community League (GWCL) is a legal entity registered under the Societies Act as a not for profit community league. We are a member of the Edmonton Federation of Community Leagues servicing residents living in Ambleside, Windermere North, South Windermere, Upper Windermere, Windermere One, Langdale, Glenridding, Riverpointe, Keswick, Westpoint Estates and Windermere Drive. The league is bounded on the north side by Anthony Henday Drive, on the south by 41 Ave SW, on the east by Whitemud Creek, and on the west by the North Saskatchewan River.

Community programming relies on the support of members. Programs that your membership support:

- Indoor and outdoor community soccer require a community league membership in order to participate.
- Community pre-schools require community league membership in order to register your child.
- Free use of the Terwilliger Recreation Centre every Saturday from 5:00pm to 7:00pm – Includes swimming, fitness center, indoor running track and, children’s indoor playground.
- Free Skate Tags for use at any of the outdoor community league rinks in Edmonton. List on www.efcl.org
- Present your GWCL membership card at any of the City of Edmonton sports and fitness facilities and receive a 20% discount on a continuous monthly pass or an annual pass and 15% off multi use passes.
