Looking for OSC (Out of School Care)?

Windermere currently has 5 licensed daycares with a 6th one planned.

The YMCA daycares that are situated at the schools begin accepting applications on January 1, 2018 for the September 2019 school year. We recommend that interested parents apply online via email on January 1st to avoid disappointment. The YMCA daycares offer childcare for Kindergarten aged children up to age 12.

The Windermere Early Learning Center offers child care to infants up to and including Kindergarten aged children. The Windermere Daycare and the Ambleside Daycare services the schools in their respective areas and include transport to and from school. These daycares have ongoing waitlists and parents are encouraged to apply early once they know their schooling plans. The Brightpath daycare is currently under construction and no opening date has been set yet.

GWCL PROGRAMMING

8-Week Kids Arts and Crafts Course

The Greater Windermere Community League (GWCL) will be offering an 8-week Arts & Crafts class at Terwillegar Recreation Center. The program will run on Wednesday nights from January 9th to February 27th, 2018 from 6:30 pm to 7:15 pm.

The focus of the program will be on developing fine motor and spatial relationship skills in young children through arts and crafts. The classes will use different art mediums so that attendees can experience different art forms. The program requires parental supervision and you are NOT allowed to leave your child unattended. For children under the age of 5, we recommend having a parent to child ratio of 1 to 1.

The cost of this class for members is \$50 per child. This is to cover the arts & crafts materials for the class. The instructor as well as the facility will be covered by the GWCL. At this time, we can only offer this program to Greater Windermere Community League members and their children between the ages of 3 and 10. Please bring a cheque or cash to the first class for the fee.

Registration will be limited to the members listed on your membership account. For insurance purposes, you cannot enroll children that are not under your guardianship - this is in case they are injured or ill and require medical attention.

8-Week Sportball Program

The Greater Windermere Community League (GWCL) is pleased to be offering an 8-week Sportball Program to its members. The program will run on Monday nights from January 7th to February 18th, 2018. There will be two offerings of the program, one at 6pm and one at 7pm. And will be offered at the Constable Daniel Woodall Public School here in Windermere.

The class at 6:00pm-6:45pm will be geared towards children under the age of 5 who are not attending Kindergarten but are mobile (can walk and run with ease). The second class at 7:00pm-7:45pm will be geared towards younger school aged children. This program requires parental supervision and you are NOT allowed to leave your child(ren) unattended.

GWCL has contracted instructors from Sportball to host these classes and is able to offer them at a discount to our members. These classes normally cost \$136 from Sportball but we will be offering the classes for \$100 per child for the 8 weeks to our members. Please bring a cheque (made out to the Greater Windermere Community League) or cash to the first class. Your child will not be allowed to participate until payment has been received.

At this time, we can only offer this program to Greater Windermere Community League Members and their children under 12 years of age (elementary school aged). However, the structure of the programming is geared towards younger children under the age of 8.

Free drop-in ESSENTRICS Stretch & Tone Fitness Classes for GWCL members!



The Greater Windermere Community League (GWCL) is a legal entity registered under the Societies Act as a not for profit community league. We are a member of the Edmonton Federation of Community Leagues servicing residents living in Ambleside, Windermere North, South Windermere, Upper Windermere, Windermere One, Langdale, Glenridding, Riverpointe, Keswick, Westpoint Estates and Windermere Drive. The league is bounded on the north side by Anthony Henday Drive, on the south by 41 Ave SW, on the east by Whitemud Creek, and on the west by the North Saskatchewan River.
